Look out kid, it's something you did
A
God knows when, but you're doing it again
You better duck down the alleyway, looking for a new friend

The man in the coonskin cap in the pig pen
A
Wants eleven dollar bills, but you only got ten

REPEAT INTRO: **A X4**

Maggie comes fleet foot, face full of black soot
Talking that the heat put plants in the bed but
The phone's tapped anyway, Maggie says that many say
They must bust in early May, orders from the D.A.

Look out kid, don't matter what you did
A
Walk on your tip toes, don't try No Doz

E7
Keep a clean nose, watch the plain clothes
A
You don't need a weather man to know which way the wind blows

D7

E7
